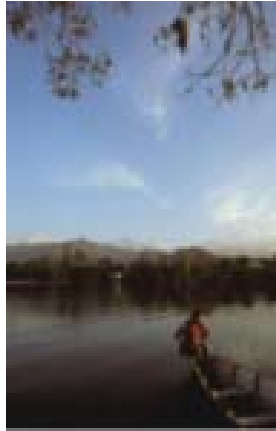


June 2010 Lake News



We have several lake issues to bring to your attention:

1. After the heavy rains on May 2 and 3 we had a red canoe float across the lake and into our yard. It has remained unclaimed. If you are missing a red canoe it has been pulled up on the face of the dam. I can be contacted at the information below. Thank you!

2. Problem: Another homeowner reports a dead goose floating upside down in the lake noting another family on the big lake has been shooting at the geese for the past couple of weeks with a high powered bb gun and has observed them kill other animals, goose eggs ,etc over the past several years.

Answer: The geese in Camden Pointe are protected by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources and it is illegal to harm these animals. The Board asks that if anyone observes such behavior that they report it either via 911 or 1-800-241-4113. The Board also asks that you report to All-In-One so we have a record of the incident.

3. Finally, a homeowner who was fishing from the small dock off the dam in the large lake has reported a copperhead snake. Our lakes are great family amenities and the teenagers really seem to love them. Please make sure your family members are aware of their surroundings and watch for snakes while enjoying the lakes.
